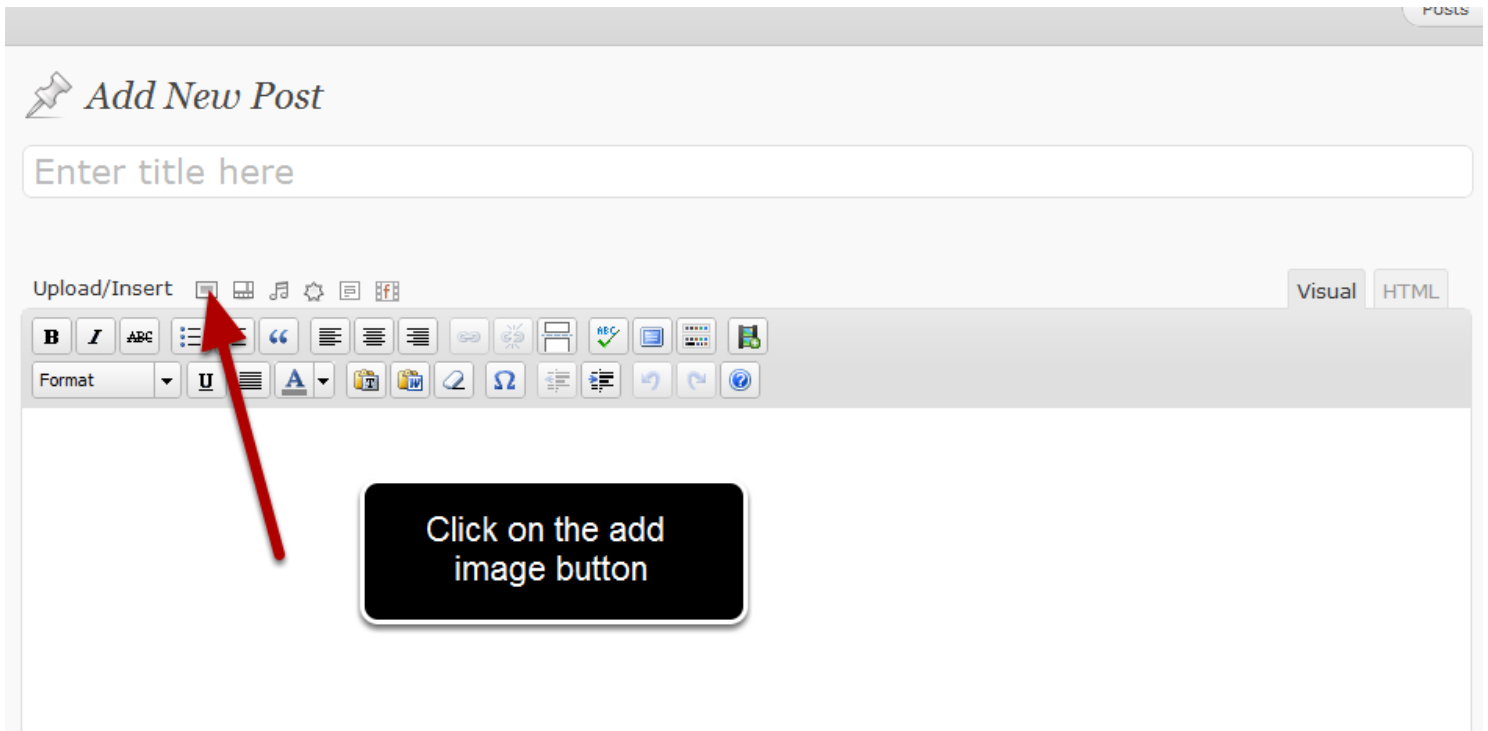


How To Add An Image to A Post Or Page

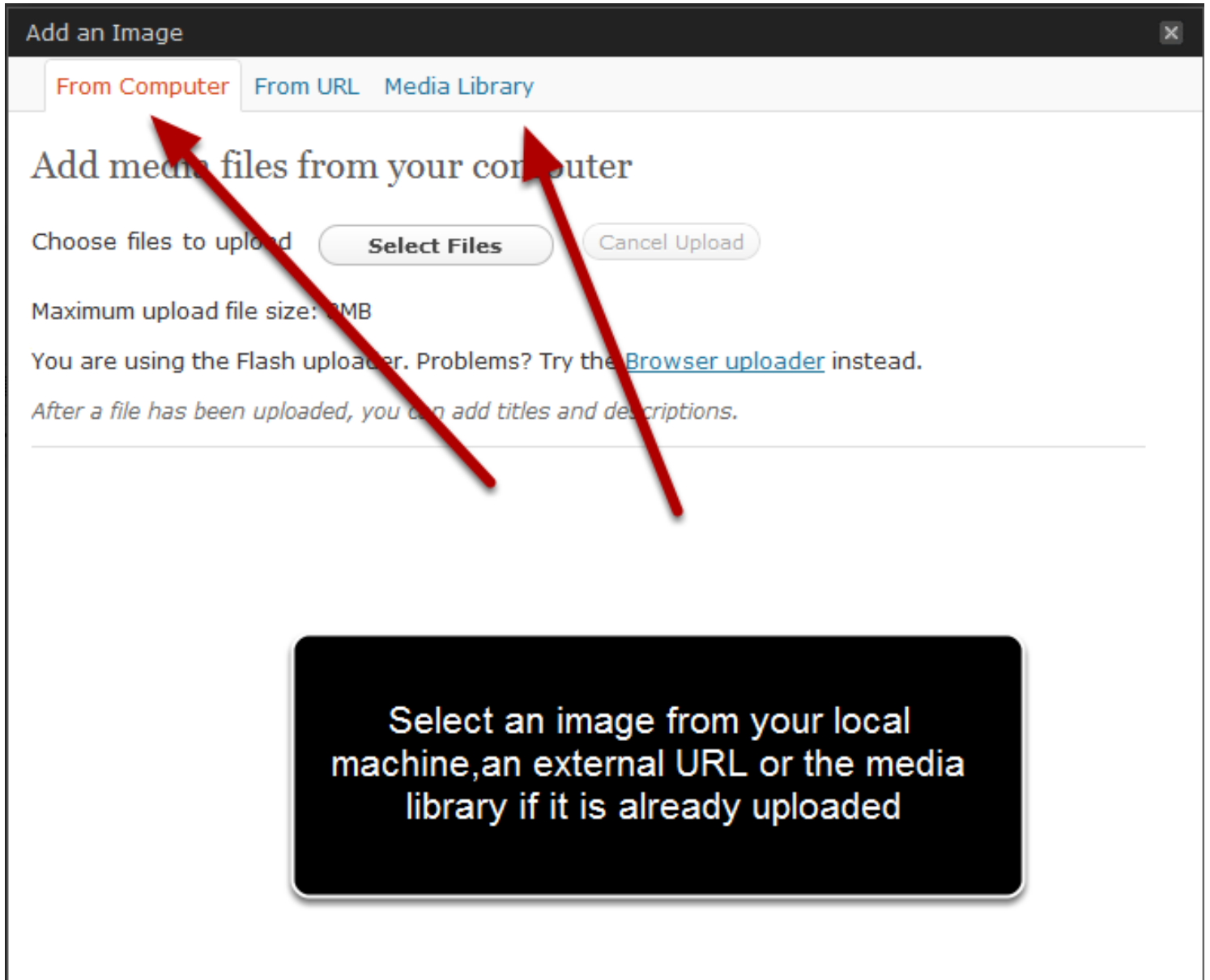
This lesson will show you how to add images into WordPress posts and pages

Open your visual editor and click on the add image button



Click on add image

The image tool is opened up, you can upload a new image or select an image from the media library
